Key Speakers



John Cowan - A former scientist in the Dept of Clinical Neurophysiology, John has wandered a strange route through youth work, social work, broadcasting and parent education. He has written many resources for teenagers on sex, mental health, life skills and other health related topics and his materials are the basis for programmes presented in 90% of New Zealand high Schools. He is currently the Creative Director for Parents Inc., responsible for the content of their publications, presentations and videos. He specializes in communicating difficult topics in a lively and humorous way, tailoring presentations to the audience.



Dr Hisham Abdalla is the first multiple laser dentist and instructor in New Zealand. He is an international speaker, author and educator in the fields of Laser dentistry, Minimally Invasive, high-tech, CAD/CAM and Cosmetic dentistry. He is an innovator in the fields of Full Face Aesthetics, combining the arts of cosmetic dentistry and cosmetic medicine. He is an invited Associate Professor at the University of Cagliari in Italy and an affiliate member of the American Dental Association. He is the NZ course provider and examiner for The Queensland University Laser Certification program, by Professor L. Walsh. Dr Hisham practices advanced dentistry and runs live courses for dental and medical professionals from all over the world, at his Laser LifeCare Institute in Auckland.



Jules Kieser BSc BDS PhD DSc FDSRCS Edinburgh, obtained a BSc from the University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa, in 1971 before going on to qualify as a dentist in 1975. He went into practice first in the outback of South Africa and subsequently in London and Johannesburg. While in practice, he received his PhD in 1989 and was appointed as Reader in Craniofacial Biology and also Honorary Professor of Anatomy at Wits. In 1996 he was appointed to the Chair, and Head of the Department of Oral Sciences, University of Otago in Dunedin, New Zealand. He currently heads the Sir John Walsh Research Institute at Otago University. His research includes biomechanics and anatomy of the oro-facial region, and forensic biology.



Estelle Pretorius is a Speech/ Language Therapist who works as an Early Intervention Specialist at McKenzie Centre in Hamilton. McKenzie Centre provides early intervention to children with delays and disorders across a range of developmental domains as well as support for families. Estelle specialises in providing Early Intervention programs for parents with children who present with Autism Spectrum Disorder. These programs provide insight and understanding of deficits and strengths of ASD and teaches parents effective strategies to promote communication and interaction with their children.

Diane Millow is a parent of an only child, who in 2009 at just 2.5 years old was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. Diane resigned from her part time job with a Medical/Surgical Sales company to devote time to her son and adjust to the new and unknown future.



Susan Birch has 20 years experience working as an exercise specialist and nutrition consultant. She holds a Masters Degree in Health Sciences and has extensive post graduate qualifications in a range of health related areas including sports medicine, musculoskeletal medicine and community nutrition. Based on current research and practical experience Susan will discuss the importance of selecting correct exercise and nutrition strategies for your body-type.

Arjuna Rajasingham graduated with a BDS from Otago in 1999. He is a member of the NZDA, NZ dentists orthodontic society, NZ society of sedation dentistry, lifetime member of the world congress of minimally invasive dentistry. He also passed by 2 year exams to become a diplomate of the world congress of minimal invasive dentistry. He completed his 2 year miniresidency in full facial orthodontics in Sydney and has completed a further 1 year mini-residency in fixed damon braces.



Marize Jones is a Bachelor of Health Science (Oral Health) AUT 2010 - currently working as a Dental Hygienist/Dental Therapist at two private practices in West Auckland.



Andrew Quick graduated as a dentist in 1990 with numerous awards that included the gold medal for best overall graduand of that year. He then spent 18 months doing research on submucosal fibrosis, and obtained an Honours degree in medical biochemistry, before becoming a lecturer in medical physiology. He qualified as an orthodontist in 1998 with distinction, and stayed on to become acting head of department, as well as running a part time private practice. He then took up a teaching position at Otago in 2000, where he obtained his M.Orth degree through the Royal College of Surgeons, Edinburgh. He was also awarded his membership of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons in 2008.
